RULES OF THE SHOW

The Pigeon Section is held under the Rules of DEFRA Licence

- 1 Pigeons will be judged under NPA & RRPA Rules.
- 2 No rail stock will be accepted. Pen numbers will be given out on arrival at the Show.
- 3 Closing date for entries will be 30 May 2025. No late entries will be accepted.
- 4 All exhibits are to be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor.
- 5 The committee reserve the right to refuse or return entries and to appoint another judge should any named judge be unable to officiate for any reason.
- Exhibits may be penned from 7.00 to 9.00 am on Wednesday 18 June. Judging will commence at 10.00 am. EXHIBITORS' VEHICLES SHOULD BE ON THE SHOWGROUND BY 8.30 AM. Lifting time for all exhibits will be 5.00 pm. Stock will be checked out.
- 7 Whilst at the Show, the whole of the exhibits are in the custody of the Show Committee and must not be handled by the exhibitor or any other person, except for the judge.
- 8 Any exhibit considered to be fraudulently prepared or a health hazard will be removed from the Show.
- 9 Every care will be taken of the exhibits, but the Society cannot be held responsible for any loss incurred before, during or after the Show.
- 10 Only litter provided by the Society may be used.
- 11 It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to feed and water birds after Judging. PLEASE NOTE EXHIBITORS ARE TO PROVIDE THEIR OWN DRINKERS.
- 12 In the interests of safety, no dogs will be allowed in the Pigeon areas.
- 13 Current animal welfare legislation applies at this Show and the Society will support any action where any breach of legislation occurs. RSPCA Officers will also be walking round the Showground to ensure the welfare of all livestock.
- 14 All electrical equipment of any description brought to the Show must have a current PAT test certificate.

- 15 Prize monies will be paid out at 4.00 pm on Show Day in the marquee.
- 16 Anyone wishing to lodge a complaint or objection may do so, in writing, and by depositing £5.50 with the Pigeon Secretary before 12 noon on Show Day. The deposit will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 17 No stock other than those entered in the Show will be admitted to the marquee. The sale of stock is strictly prohibited.
- 18 Trophies remain the property of the Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO and will <u>not</u> be given out. There will be the opportunity for the winning exhibitor to be photographed with the trophy at the Trophy Marquee.
- 19 Any exhibitor on making entries is deemed to have read and agreed to abide by these rules.
- 20 Any exhibitor, on making entries £16.50 or over £30 will receive two free exhibitor ticket.
- 21 Car passes will be issued to exhibitors at the discretion of the Society as space for parking is limited. Exhibitors who receive car passes must agree to park in the areas allocated. There is no charge for parking.
- 22 All entries to be made online www.rcs.entrymaster.online

From the North

Leave M6 at Junction 20 (Lymm interchange) - Follow Show signs along A50 towards High Legh and Knutsford. Continue following signs to the Show.

From the South

Traffic using A50 from the south, follow Show signs when approaching Holmes Chapel, to A54 road for Middlewich.

Traffic using M6, leave M6 at Junction 18 (Holmes Chapel interchange). Turn left on to A54 towards Middlewich. At the roundabout approaching Middlewich follow Show signs turning right (A530) towards Northwich. Turn right at traffic lights and continue towards Northwich for about 4 miles to roundabout at junction with A556. Continue to follow Show signs and directions.

From East or West

Leave M56 at Junction 10 and take A559 signposted Northwich. In Antrobus village, turn left and continue to follow Show signs.

When approaching the showground ignore SAT-NAV directions
