RULES OF THE SHOW

EGG SECTION – TUESDAY

The Egg Section is held under the Rules of DEFRA Licence.

- 1 The Show is to be held under Poultry Club Rules,
The Poultry Club Representative at the Show is Mr J Benson.
- 2 Plate numbers for EGGS will be by Catalogue Cost £1.00.
- 3 **Closing date for entries will be 30th May No late entries will be accepted.**
- 4 All exhibits are to be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor.
- 5 The committee reserve the right to refuse or return entries without an explanation and to appoint another Judge should any named Judge be unable to officiate for any reason.
- 6 Exhibits may be penned between 5.00 pm and 7.00 pm No Later on Monday 16th June.
Or on show day before 8.30 am Judging will commence At 9.30 am. Lifting time for all exhibits will be 5.00 pm.
- 7 Whilst at the Show, the whole of the exhibits are in the custody of the Show Committee and must not be handled by the exhibitor or any other person.
- 8 Any exhibit considered being fraudulently prepared or a health hazard will be removed from the Show.
- 9 Every care will be taken of the exhibits, but the Society cannot be held responsible for any loss incurred before, during or after the Show.
- 10 Only Plates and Sawdust provided by the Society may be used.
- 11 Prize monies for Egg Section will be paid out at 4.30 pm on Show Day in the Egg Marquee. Any prize money not collect on show day will be deemed a donation to the society.
- 12 Anyone wishing to lodge a complaint or objection may do so, in writing, and by depositing £10.00 with the Chief Poultry Steward before 12 noon on Show Day.
The deposit will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 13 All perpetual cups and trophies remain the property of Cheshire Agricultural Society.
No Trophies will be allowed to be removed from the EGG Marquee you can if you wish take a photograph but Trophies cannot be taken.
- 14 Any exhibitor, making entries, is deemed to have read and agreed to abide by these rules.
- 15 Any exhibitor making entries totalling £12.00 will qualify for one free entry pass.
Entries totalling over £18.00 will qualify for one extra pass.
Cheaper advance rate admission tickets to the Show may be obtained by application to the Show Secretary prior to the Show Day, prices for these are:
ADULT: £30.00 CHILD: £13.00 (CHILD 5-7 YEARS) Family: £75.00 (2 Adults 2 Children).
- 16 Car passes will be issued to exhibitors at the discretion of the Society, as space for parking is limited. Exhibitors who receive car passes must agree to park in the areas allocated.
There is no charge for parking.

Examples of bodies we may need to share your data with include but are not limited to: caterers who need to be aware of special dietary requirements, breed societies to verify entries, external contractors such as marquee and electricity suppliers and for safety purposes your emergency contact details may be shared with relevant bodies.

The Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO recognises that you have rights surrounding the data we hold. Individuals may contact the Society's Data Protection Officer (DPO) and exercise your rights to be informed about the data we hold, have access to the data we hold, have your data rectified, your right to be forgotten and so forth. Should you make a data request the Society will endeavour to respond within the statutory period.

The Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO will endeavour to keep your data safe and will notify you and the Information Commissioners Officer (ICO) should it become aware of any data breach, within the legal time limit of 72 hours. If you are not satisfied at any time with the actions of the Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO, you have the right to contact the ICO at ico.org.uk or via their helpline on 0303 123 1113.

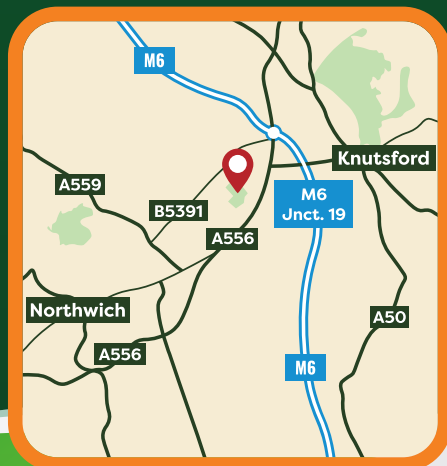

From the North

Leave M6 at Junction 20 (Lymm interchange) - Follow Show signs along A50 towards High Legh and Knutsford. Continue following signs to the Show.

From the South

Traffic using A50 from the south, follow Show signs when approaching Holmes Chapel, to A54 road for Middlewich.

Traffic using M6, leave M6 at Junction 18 (Holmes Chapel interchange). Turn left on to A54 towards Middlewich. At the roundabout approaching Middlewich follow Show signs turning right (A530) towards Northwich. Turn right at traffic lights and continue towards Northwich for about 4 miles to roundabout at junction with A556. Continue to follow Show signs and directions.

From East or West


Leave M56 at Junction 10 and take A559 signposted Northwich. In Antrobus village, turn left and continue to follow Show signs.

When approaching the showground ignore SAT-NAV directions
