

## The Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO - Data Protection Policy

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) became a legal requirement on 25 May 2018. The Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO is committed to protecting your data. This brief policy sets out the basis on which any personal data that you provide to us, or that we may receive from others about you, will be processed. Data may be held electronically or in paper format and will only be held for a reasonable length of time.

The Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO recognises its position as both controller and processor of your data with regards to The Royal Cheshire County Show. The Society will only use your data and share your data when it has a legitimate reason to do so. You may provide data to us when joining the Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO, booking a trade stand or entering a competition held at The Royal Cheshire County Show. Examples of bodies we may need to share your data with include but are not limited to: caterers who need to be aware of special dietary requirements, breed societies to verify entries, external contractors such as marquee and electricity suppliers and for safety purposes your emergency contact details may be shared with relevant bodies.

The Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO recognises that you have rights surrounding the data we hold. Individuals may contact the Society's Data Protection Officer (DPO) and exercise your rights to be informed about the data we hold, have access to the data we hold, have your data rectified, your right to be forgotten and so forth. Should you make a data request the Society will endeavour to respond within the statutory period.

The Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO will endeavour to keep your data safe and will notify you and the Information Commissioners Officer (ICO) should it become aware of any data breach, within the legal time limit of 72 hours. If you are not satisfied at any time with the actions of the Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO, you have the right to contact the ICO at [ico.org.uk](http://ico.org.uk) or via their helpline on 0303 123 1113.

### **DISCLAIMER**

Whilst the Society will take all reasonable steps to prevent accidents to persons or injury to property, neither the Society nor its Officers or Servants accept responsibility for such accidents or injuries howsoever caused and whether or not involving negligence on the part of any such officers or servants. The Show, its Officers or Servants, shall not be responsible for any accident, damage or loss however caused, that may occur to any exhibitor or his servant, or to any article, animal, or property brought into the Showground, or while entering or leaving the Showground. Each exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may have been done to or occasioned by, or arising from, any machinery, or other article, or any animal or property exhibited by him. It is a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall indemnify and hold harmless the Show from and against all actions, suits and claims on account of such damage or injury. The Society through its Secretary (or Show Director) shall have full and free right to refuse to accept any entry, to cancel any entry after being made and accepted, to refuse admission to the Showground of any proposed exhibit and/or to remove or order to be removed at the risk and expense of the owner thereof any exhibit which has been admitted to the Showground. There shall be no obligation upon the Show Committee to make or offer any explanation or reason for any such action, and the Show Committee shall not incur any liability or responsibility in this matter.

### **PLEASE NOTE**

- a) Under no circumstances can an entry be moved from one class to another, or substitutions made (please refer to Show Rules).
- b) Tickets, exhibit numbers and passes will be sent to the name and address on the Entries Statement in early June.
- c) Passports must be brought to the show.

Trophies remain the property of the Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO and will **NOT** be given out. There will be the opportunity for the winning Exhibitor to be photographed with the trophy at the Trophy Marquee. We would ask that you treat our volunteers with the utmost respect in this matter as they are conforming to the wishes of the Society. Failure to do so will result in either a loss of prize money and/or exclusion from the show for a period of 12 months.

### **PRIZE MONEY & FORWARD PAYMENTS**

All money will be sent via an email link to the exhibitor who entered after the show. This could take up to a month in some circumstances. Prize money will only be given if the exhibitor shows in the grand parade.

### **DRESS FOR SHOWING**

All exhibitors **MUST** wear a suit or smart jacket with a tie. In cold conditions, a suitable smart topcoat is acceptable. Exhibitors should only discard jackets by the express permission of the Judge.

Ladies are reminded that the dress code also applies to them. Please note that bare arms are not acceptable. Gilets (tweed or other colour) are not acceptable in the show ring. We also remind in-hand handlers that smart trousers should be worn. Jeans are not acceptable.

Suitable footwear should be worn. Wellington boots, trainers, slip on shoes and open toes shoes are unsafe and are not acceptable.

The dress code will be enforced for classes and for the Grand Parades.

### **DRESS CODE FOR WOMEN**

The dress code above also applies to women. Showing of horses in short sleeves, gilets, jodhpurs (except ridden classes) is not permissible.

### **OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE**

Exhibitors in all competitive classes (except foals, yearlings and ridden classes if the horses are stripped) are strictly prohibited from receiving any help, assistance or change of handler unless in the case of an emergency or serious threat of harm or risk to the exhibitor, other exhibitors, horses or any other individual. Exhibitors of foals and yearlings are permitted to have an assistant if needed for the individual 'show', and exhibitors of ridden horses are permitted to have an assistant if the horse is required to be stripped of the saddle. All assistants must be dressed appropriately for the show ring. They must not enter the ring until required and must leave the ring as soon as the relevant animal has completed its 'show' and returned to the line-up. In the event of a breach of this rule the exhibitor and person/persons providing such assistance will be disqualified from the Class. For the avoidance of doubt, this also includes 'whipping up'.

- 3 Entries cannot be accepted at Affiliated Shows in classes for Shires or Heavy Horses from any person who has been either suspended or removed from membership of the Shire Horse Society or has been excluded from exhibiting for prizes at Shows, Sales or Exhibitions or from taking part in any Show organised by the Shire Horse Society.
- 4 No animal to be eligible to take more than one Silver Spoon during any one year. The Shire Horse Society Spring Show being excepted.
- 5 THE WINNING ANIMAL MUST BE REGISTERED OR ELIGIBLE FOR REGISTRATION IN THE STUD BOOK OR GRADE B REGISTER.
- 6 The Judge invited to officiate must be on the Society's Official Panel and has the right to withhold the award of the Silver Spoon and Rosette if an exhibit does not show sufficient merit.
- 7 The Council reserve the right in offering Spoons, to award them only to persons approved by the Shire Horse Society.

#### **Please Note**

Spoons will be dispatched to winners directly from the Shire Horse Society.

## SHOW RULES

- 1 **ENTRY FEES** Under no circumstances will Entry Fees be returned in the case of cancellation of entries by an Exhibitor or because of postponement or cancellation of the Show for whatever reason.
- 2 Under no circumstances can an entry be moved from one class to another, or rider or horse substitutions made.
- 3 All animals must be the bona-fide property of the Exhibitor at the time of entry.
- 4 All animals must be provided with ties, and all animals must be halter led in the rings.
- 5 Any person in charge of livestock exhibits who places the stock in their charge in any other place than that allocated to them or who removes or alters any number or name indicating the position of their exhibit, will be liable to expulsion from the Showground and their animals may be debarred from competition.
- 6 **ATTENDANTS** Exhibitors or their attendants must remain with their exhibits during the whole time they are at the Show and must comply with and be governed by the Society's Rules and Regulations.
- 7 **HEADWEAR** Anyone riding a horse must wear a hat to British Standard specification and of a standard approved by the governing body of their respective horse society.
- 8 **DRESS** Exhibitors should be smartly dressed, gentlemen in smart jacket, trousers, shirt and tie, ladies in trousers or skirt, smart jacket and blouse. Strictly no jeans.
- 9 **NUMBERING OF EXHIBITS** All exhibits must display the number supplied by the Society for the appropriate class during judging or in the Parade. Failure to comply with this rule may result in mistakes being made on prize money payouts.
- 10 **JUDGING** will commence as near as circumstances allow at the times stated in the Schedule, under the respective sectional headings and Exhibitors will be responsible for their Exhibits being in their respective Ring at the proper time.
- 11 **JUDGES** The Judges named in the Society's Prize Schedule and Show Catalogue or Programme have consented and have been appointed to act as Judges in the events indicated. The Committee reserve the right to appoint substitutes for any who may be unavoidably prevented from attending and all entries are accepted upon that understanding.
- 12 Trophies remain the property of the Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO and will NOT be given out. There will be the opportunity for the winning Exhibitor to be photographed with the trophy at the Trophy Marquee.
- 13 **PROTESTS** Any Exhibitor wishing to lodge a protest must do so in writing to the Executive Director (within one hour of completion of judging) on the Show Day together with the sum of £25. All protests to be investigated by a committee consisting of at least three members of the Council whose decision shall be final.
- 14 **PRIZE MONEY** – will be paid directly into the account used to make the entries. This could take up to a month in some circumstances.
- 15 **STEWARDS** The Committee delegates full power to the Stewards to enforce the Society's Rules and Regulations.
- 16 **TROPHIES** remain the property of the Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO and will **NOT** be given out. There will however be the opportunity for the winning exhibitor to be photographed with the trophy at the Trophy Marquee.
- 17 **PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE** Exhibitors must carry adequate public liability cover.
- 18 **BREED SOCIETIES** All persons entering, competing or exhibiting an animal in a Class covered by a Breed Society either to which the Society is affiliated, or which is affiliated to the Society shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the relevant Breed Society and be subject to its constitution and rules (including any disciplinary procedures) insofar as they are applicable to any event, competition or display promoted or arranged by this Society.
- 19 **POSTPONEMENT OR ABANDONMENT** Exhibitors shall not have any claim against the Society or any member of the Society in respect of any loss or damage whatsoever consequent upon the Show failing (for whatever reason) to be held.
- 20 **TEMPORARY PADDOCKS** Exhibitors to remove temporary paddocks by 7.00 am on the Tuesday of the Show.
- 21 **CURRENT ANIMAL WELFARE LEGISLATION** applies at this Show and the Society will support any action where any breach of such legislation occurs.
- 22 **ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT** brought to the Show must have a current PAT test certificate.
- 23 **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. 1st June closing date**
